Fukushu Garden

2 Hours suggested

Fukushūen Garden in downtown Naha, built in 1992, celebrates its sister city relationship with Fuzhou, China. This serene garden features traditional Chinese design, a koi pond, a waterfall, an artificial cave, pavilions, and the zodiac bridge adorned with 12 Chinese zodiac animals. It's free, peaceful, and perfect for a relaxing stroll.

The Ryukyu Glass Craft Factory in Itoman, Okinawa, showcases unique glass items and offers a hands-on glassmaking experience. The Himeyuri Peace Museum and Cenotaph in Okinawa honors the Himeyuri Student Corps, schoolgirls conscripted as nurse assistants during the 1945 Battle of Okinawa. Located in a peaceful park south of Naha, it features a cenotaph for visitors to pay respects. The museum's poignant exhibits include photographs, personal items, reconstructed wartime shelters, and testimonies from survivors, offering a profound insight into the human cost of war and the importance of peace.

The Mabuni Peace Park, located in Okinawa's Mabuni hills, commemorates the final World War II battle on the island. The museum offers narratives of the war, personal stories, and the impact of the U.S. military. Key exhibits include a replica Okinawan cave and stones engraved with names of fallen soldiers. The park features walkways, rest areas, and libraries for reflection. English translations and a post-war town exhibit from the 60s and 70s are available for
